NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing the suspension order dated 27.09.2012 (Annexure P-1) and for directing the respondents to reinstate the petitioner in service and allow him to rejoin the duty in the Bank together with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset confines her prayer for deciding representation dated 19.06.2023 (Annexure P-7) submitted by the petitioner. She submits that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied, if the said representation is decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Rajesh Sehgal, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 and 2 and

submits that representation filed by the petitioner shall be decided expeditiously.

5. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition, respondent No.3 is directed to consider and decide the claim made by the petitioner in representation dated 19.06.2023 (Annexure P-7) in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

6. The petition stands disposed of.
