Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to conduct the demarcation of the land of the petitioner which is pending since 2021 before respondent No.4. The representation dated 29.08.2023 (Annexure P-8) of the petitioner is also still lying un-attended in the office of respondent No.2.

In compliance of order dated 09.02.2024, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, Tehsildar Bholath is present in person in the Court who has apprised this Court that due to the unavailability of staff, demarcation as prayed by the petitioner could not be conducted. However, it is submitted that notices have already been issued to all the parties concerned and the demarcation would be conducted in their presence on Monday i.e. 26.02.2024. He has assured that no further delay would be caused for the redressal of the grievance raised by the petitioner in this Court.

In view of the above submissions, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.4 to carry out the

demarcation as submitted on Monday i.e. 26.02.2024 in the presence of all the parties concerned. The report of the demarcation would be provided to the petitioner forthwith. Petitioner would be at liberty to pursue his remedy in case any further cause of action accrues to him.
