1. The instant writ petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of certiorari for quashing the order dated 13.12.2021 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.2-Secretary, Punjab Mandi Board, SAS Nagar (Mohali), whereby suspension order No.569 dated 14.10.2021 of respondent No.4-Sh. Sumit Kumar, Market Supervisor, Market Committee, Qadian passed by the petitioner, has been stayed and further sought a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to take appropriate action on the representation/appeal submitted by him.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents submit that since the suspension of respondent No.4 has already been revoked vide order dated 24.04.2023 passed by the District Mandi Officer, Gurdaspur,
