AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

1. The present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to revise the pension/family pension in respect of the late husband of the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel would submit that the petitioner is seeking revision of his family pension with effect from 01.01.2006, as per the Notification dated 17.08.2009 and 22.02.2010. In this regard, a legal notice dated 20.09.2023 (Annexure P-4), has been submitted, which has not yet evoked any response. He thus, at this stage, on instructions, submits that the petitioner is sanguine of it being considered in a positive manner, in case, a direction is given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner by granting her an opportunity of hearing.
3. Notice of motion.
4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Gagneshwar Walia, Addl. AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has no objection to the limited prayer made.

5. In view of the aforesaid and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider the legal notice dated 20.09.2023, Annexure P-4 and decide the same taking note of the Notification as referred to, by the petitioner, within a period of 6 weeks and if found entitled, necessary benefits be granted forthwith. However, in the eventuality of the relief being denied, a speaking order be passed, after associating the petitioner therewith.
