During the hearing of the application for suspension of sentence, it has been brought to our notice that while undergoing treatment at Government Medical College, Faridkot on 13.05.2024 the appellant had suffered an injury on his head and had, thereafter, expired on 22.05.2024. In view of the above said fact, it is apparent that the main appeal itself is abated and same is, accordingly, taken up on Board and disposed off.

2. In pursuance of order dated 12.07.2024, short reply, by way of affidavit of Shri N.D. Negi, Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda dated 18.07.2024, has been filed. Vide the said order, it was further directed that the Civil Surgeon, Bathinda shall look into the matter and file his report, but the same has not been filed.

3. Resultantly, keeping in view the above, since the present appeal is disposed of as having been abated, the Civil Surgeon, Bathinda shall file his report within a period of four weeks with the Registrar General of this Court, in pursuance of the order dated 12.07.2024.
