

4. Notice of motion.
5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Surender Singh, AAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents.
6. Without commenting on the validity of the marriage of the parties, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, Haryana, to consider the representation (Annexure P-5) keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and if so warranted, take action, to ensure protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners, strictly in accordance with law.
7. This order is not to be construed as any opinion with regard to the age of the petitioners or factum or validity of their marriage in any civil or criminal proceedings nor the petitioners would be entitled for any protection against their arrest or continuance of any criminal proceedings, if otherwise, found to be involved in commission of any cognizable offence(s).
