1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner as Assistant Pump Operator.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get further instructions from the LR's of the petitioner.
