1. The petitioner has approached this Court through instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to step-up the pay and pension of the petitioner w.e.f. 24.07.2009, who is a general category employee to catch up at par with his junior colleagues.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that since the relief claimed in the present petition with regard to stepping-up of pay and revised pension has already been granted by the respondents vide order dated 26.06.2023 (Annexure R-1) and the revised PPO on 07.07.2023, therefore, the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner could not dispute the abovesaid facts.

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4. In view of the above, the instant writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
