1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing the charge-sheet dated 22.05.2018 (Annexure P/32) issued to the petitioner by respondent No.3 under Rule 8 of the Punjab Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1970.

2. After arguing the case for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all his pleas, as have been raised in the present petition, before the competent authority i.e. respondent No.3. He further submits that the petitioner has already submitted detailed written submissions dated 07.02.2024 (Annexure P/33A) to respondent No.3 which may be considered while passing the final order.

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3. On receipt of advance copy of the petition, Mr. Manbir Singh Batth, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.3 and submits that the pleas as have been raised in the written submissions dated 07.02.2024 given by the petitioner shall be considered by respondent No.3, while finalizing the disciplinary proceedings.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
