This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents no.3 and 4 to get House No.73 Type III, Revenue Colony, Rohtak vacated from respondent no.5 and deliver possession to the petitioner forthwith.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, respondent-State and private respondent have jointly submitted that respondent no.5 has handed over the possession of the house on 01.03.2024 to the House Allotment Committee and further possession has been handed over to the petitioner on 02.03.2024 and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
