The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.01 dated 03.01.2024 registered under Sections 420, 489-A, 489-B, 489-C (wrongly typed as 498C in the rejection order), 120B of the IPC, 1860 at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 13.02.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 22.04.2024 by way of an affidavit of Murad Jasvir Singh Gill, PPS, Asstt. Commissioner of Police (West), Ludhiana has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 13.02.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
