1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, impugning the order dated 09.01.1997, (Annexure P-7), whereby the petitioners have been reverted from the post of Junior Clerks to that of Class-IV posts and further writ of mandamus has been sought to promote the petitioners as Junior Clerks retrospectively against 10% quota reserved for the Class-IV employees and also in view of the fact that respondent Nos.3 and 4 were not possessing the requisite qualification at the time of availability of the vacancies of Junior Clerks.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 22.02.2024, the following order was passed:-

"Learned counsel for respondent No.2-Bank submits that since both the petitioners have retired from the post of Clerk on 28.02.2011 and 31.07.2012, respectively and petitioner No.2 has unfortunately died on 23.06.2017, therefore, the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

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Let notice be issued to the office of Sh. R.K. Chopra, Senior Advocate, for 11.03.2024."

3. Learned counsel for respondent No.2-Bank submits that even, respondent Nos.3 and 4 have also stood retired from service.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he has no instructions from the petitioners as the brief has been taken by the petitioners.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to the petitioners for revival of the present petition, in case anything still survives.
