This is a petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated 09.06.2020 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Inspector General of Police Hisar Range, Hisar. Other prayers have also been made in the present petition.

2. Learned State counsel has pointed out that the petitioner had moved an application for seeking voluntary retirement, which has been allowed, vide order dated 19.10.2023 and a copy of the said order has been handed over to this Court during the course of the hearing, which is taken on record and has been marked as "Mark A". It is further submitted that in view of the same, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the above, has submitted that the present writ petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, but liberty be granted to the petitioner to revive the present petition, in case any cause arises in future.
