Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the order dated 04.08.1997 (Annexure P-7) vide which respondent No.3 has been promoted to the post of Assistant Engineer (C). Further a writ of mandamus has been sought for directing the respondents to promote the petitioner to the post of Assistant Engineer (C).

There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on 24.04.2024 and 22.05.2024.

As per office report, the petitioner has been duly served, however, none has put in appearance on his behalf even today. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the petitioner has already been retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 29.08.2014. He further submits that in the memo of parties, father's name of respondent No.3 has not been mentioned, therefore, the exact



information with regard to respondent No.3 could not be ascertained, however, there were three employees in the name of Surjit Singh of respondent No.2 and all of them have already been retired from service. With regard to service of respondent No.4, in terms of last order, office report indicates that notices issued to him has received back unserved as he has not been found at the given address. Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2 stated that there was no employee in the name of Sukinderpal Singh, however, two employees in the name of Surinderpal have also been retired from service.

Since there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner on three consecutive dates, therefore, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
