HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (Oral)

1. In the present petition, the only grievance of the petitioners is that their pension is not credited in their account immediately at the start of the month, which is causing great financial difficulties to the pensioners as they have no other means to support their livelihood.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that all the efforts will be made to credit the pension of the petitioners in their respective accounts by 7th of every month so that, no grievance is raised by the petitioners and the petitioners are able to lead their life in a dignified way as envisaged under Article 21 of the Constitution of India.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, their grievance stands redressed, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further, with liberty to revive the same in case the undertaking given by the learned State counsel is not complied with.
