1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and her family at the hands of respondents No.5 to 8. The petitioner is also seeking issuance of directions to official respondents for conducting free and fair investigation by referring the matter to some independent agency like CBI or by constituting a Special Investigation Team (SIT) in FIR No.152 dated 24.10.2023 under Section 346 of the IPC registered at Police Station Sirhali, District Tarn Taran.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions could be issued to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into her representation dated 25.12.2023 (Annexure P-6) which was sent through a registered post and take appropriate steps at the earliest.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Amandeep Singh Samra,

AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In view of the restricted prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the representation dated 25.12.2023 (Annexure P-6) and take appropriate steps, if any, required, in accordance with law.
