1. On 19.02.2024, the following order was passed:-

“This appeal has come up for hearing after a period of 36 years.

As per the office report, respondent No.1(i) is reported to be dead, whereas, notice sent to respondent No.2(ii) has been received back served.

Respondent No.2(i) was not found residing at the given address.

This appeal has been filed by the plaintiff.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the last opportunity is granted to the appellant to take steps for bringing on record the legal representatives of respondent No.1(i) and furnish the correct address of respondent No.2(i) within a period of 10 days from today.

If the application is filed, the office will list the same immediately before the Bench, however, if the appellant fails to take steps within the aforesaid period, the appeal shall be deemed to have been dismissed for non-prosecution without further reference to the Court.

2. As per the office report, the learned counsel representing the appellant has not taken any steps in compliance with the order dated 19.02.2024.
3. Hence, dismissed for non-prosecution.
