Prayer in this petition is for quashing of notice dated 03.04.2021 (Annexure P-10) issued under Section 13 (2) and notice dated 03.01.2022 (Annexure P-14) issued under Section 13 (4) of Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act (for short SARFAESI Act).

2. Affidavit has been filed on behalf of respondent Bank stating that notice under Section 13(4) of Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act (for short SARFAESI Act) has been withdrawn as it came to light that objections raised by petitioner have not been decided. It is submitted that necessary steps would be taken only after considering and deciding the objections raised by petitioner, who is also free to raise any fresh objection(s) if, so advised.

3. In view of above, learned counsel for petitioner is unable to deny that present writ petition is indeed rendered infructuous.

4. Accordingly, present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to petitioner to file fresh/additional objections, within a period of one week

from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order and in case of any subsequent grievance petitioner would be at liberty to avail statutory remedies available to him in accordance with law for redressal of his grievance(s). Pending civil miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
