1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners, who are husband and wife and working in the same Department i.e. Prison Department, Haryana but have been posted at a different station, which is causing prejudice to them. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that both the petitioners can be posted at the same station but no action is being taken by the respondents despite the fact that as per the policy issued by the Government of Haryana, where husband and wife are in Government service, all the efforts should be made to post them at same station so that no prejudice is caused to them.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already filed a representation claiming the same relief dated 15.12.2023, copy of which has been appended with this petition as

Annexure P-3 hence, the respondents be directed to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the representation dated 15.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) has not been decided by the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the authorities concerned within a period of four weeks of the receipt of copy of this order.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
