1. Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the impugned order dated 20.11.2023 (Annexure P-8) vide which the petitioner has been dismissed from service.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that against the aforesaid order dated 20.11.2023 (Annexure P-8), a departmental appeal dated 04.01.2024 (Annexure P-10) has been preferred by the petitioner which is still pending consideration with the Appellate Authority and he would be satisfied if time bound directions are issued to the Appellate Authority to consider and decide the said appeal.
3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Ravi Dutt Sharma, DAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Appellate Authority to consider and decide the appeal dated 04.01.2024 (Annexure P-10) filed by the petitioner within a period of 04 months, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to supplement the said appeal within a period of 02 weeks from today.

7. If any such supplementary appeal is filed by the petitioner, the same shall also be considered and decided, in accordance with law.
