The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for directing the official respondents to do coordination or appointment of Warrant Officer to search the alleged detainee namely Jinny Goyal who is stated to be in illegal custody of respondent No.4 to 6.

2. It is *inter alia* contended that the petitioner happens to be the father of Jinny Goyal aged about 20 years and it is claimed that she under the influence of respondent No.4 to 6 is not joining the company of the petitioner. He submits that even earlier the daughter of the petitioner Jinny Goyal had filed CRWP No. 857 of 2024 which was decided on 31.01.2024 (Annexure P-6) giving directions to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the representation moved by her. He further contends that

petitioner has also moved representation dated 25.01.2024 (Annexure P-5) to Deputy Superintendent of Police, Patti, but no action was taken thereon and even the petitioner has moved representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran dated 09.02.2024 (Annexure P-7). He submits that petitioner will be satisfied, if, appropriate directions are given to respondent No.2 Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to consider and dispose of the representation dated 09.02.2024 (Annexure P-7) in accordance with law, in an expeditious manner, after giving opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

3. Heard.
4. In view of above, limited prayer made by the counsel for the petitioner, respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran is directed to consider and dispose of representation dated 09.02.2024 (Annexue P-7) moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law, after giving opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, in an expeditious manner, preferably within 3 weeks from today. The decision so taken, be intimated to the petitioner.
5. Petition stands disposed of in above terms.
