The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C with a prayer to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to her in case arising out of FIR No.13, dated 21.01.2021, under Sections 420, 120-B of IPC(66-B of I.T., Act added later on), Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1).
