1. Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of *certiorari* quashing the impugned order (condition No.1) dated 23.01.2014 (Annexure P-3) i.e. permanently debarring the petitioner for re-promotion as Supervisory Accounts Services (SAS) Accountant.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has already submitted legal notice dated 09.01.2024 (Annexure P-8) and he may be given liberty to supplement the said legal notice and the same may be considered and decided by the respondents in a time-bound manner.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record of the case.

4. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition,

respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide the claim made in legal notice dated 09.01.2024 (Annexure P-8) and supplementary legal notice, moved by the petitioner within a period of one month, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months thereafter.

5. The petition stands disposed of.
