Through the instant petition, prayer has been made for quashing of the FIR No.0193 dated 04.09.2014 registered at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 148, 149 IPC, on the basis of compromise dated 29.11.2019 (Annexure P-2)

Despite opportunities granted, the complainant did not cause appearance to get his statement recorded to verify the factum of compromise.

It is further submitted that the petitioner No.1, has already been declared a proclaimed offender, as per the report sent by the learned trial Court concerned.

Therefore, no ground is made out to quash the FIR, on the basis of compromise.

The instant petition is ordered to be dismissed. However, liberty is granted to approach this Court in case, the compromise is fully effected between the parties concerned.
