AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner Kulwinder Singh has filed petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 138 dated 12.11.2023, registered under Sections 379-B/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Jodhewal, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana (Annexure P-1).
2. Brief facts of the case are that Arun Kumar complainant gave his statement that on 26.10.2023, he was returning home and at about 09:20 PM, he reached near Government School, Village Kakowal, Ludhiana. One Verna car bearing Registration No. PB-10-CR-9536 colour silver stopped near him from which three boys alighted and he was made to sit in car forcibly. He was given beating. His mobile phone make One Plus Nord CE2 Lite 5G and cash amounting to Rs. 25,000/- were snatched and



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he was thrown out of the car near shop of Property Dealer, Kakowal. With these allegations, present FIR was registered.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner pointed out that he was arrested in this case on 25.11.2023. He was granted *interim* bail vide order dated 22.04.2024. He has already joined the investigation. It is prayed that his *interim* bail order may kindly be confirmed.

4. Bail application is opposed by learned counsel representing the State.

5. I have considered the arguments. It is confirmed by learned counsel representing the State that challan in this case was presented on 23.01.2024 and charge-sheet has been framed. It is further confirmed that he is not involved in any other case. Considering the aforesaid factual position, without expressing my mind on the merits of case, *interim* bail already granted in favour of petitioner Kulwinder Singh vide order dated 22.04.2024 stands confirmed, on the same terms and conditions as mentioned in said order.

6. Petition is accordingly allowed.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
