1.                Counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.4, who is serving as Assistant Sub-Inspector in Punjab Police and is presently posted in Police Station City Nakodar, District Jalandhar is unnecessarily harassing the petitioner by calling him to the police station, time and again. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) to look into the matter and decide representation dated 18.12.2023 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner in a time bound manner.
2.                Notice of motion.
3.                Mr. Jasjeet Singh Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and on instructions from ASI Sarabjit Singh submits that actually petitioner is having civil as well as criminal



litigation with respondent No.5 and intends to exert pressure on the local police under the guise of the present petition. State counsel further submits that anyhow if any such representation filed by the petitioner is pending the same will be considered and decided by the competent authority, in accordance with law.

4. In light of the above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) to consider and decide representation dated 18.12.2023 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of next two months, after getting verified the facts of the case. It is further made clear that the present order will be having no bearing on the civil or criminal litigation, if any, pending between the petitioner and private respondents. The said litigation, if any, pending between the parties is to be decided on the basis of its own facts and circumstances by the Court concerned.

5. The present petition is hereby disposed of, in aforesaid terms.
