1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 23.11.2022 passed in CWP-26892-2022.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 23.11.2022 passed in CWP-26892-2022 has been complied with and speaking order dated 29.03.2023 has been passed.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order passed by the respondent/concerned authority.
