1. The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C., has been invoked seeking direction to respondents particularly to respondent No.4 to take the petitioner under armed police escort to State Bank of India, Branch-Old DC Road, Sonipat to enable him to access and withdraw cash amount from his bank account so that he may pay his counsel expenses and hand over the remaining amount to his old aged parents for their livelihood.
2. At the outset, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.4- Superintendent, District Jail Rohtak to decide the application dated 12.12.2023 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner, which is still pending in a time bound manner.
3. Notice to the official respondents only at this state.
4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Baljinder Singh Virk, Sr. DAG, Haryana having served with an advance notice, accepts the same on behalf of respondent

State of Haryana. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply requisite copies of the petition to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, respondent No.4-Superintendent, District Jail Rohtak is directed to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his application dated 12.12.2023 (Annexure P-1) and to decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. In view of the afore-said terms, the present petition is disposed off.
