1. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C, the petitioner has sought directions to the official respondent No.2 to get the investigation transferred to some senior police officers.
2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that a false case has been planted upon Kirpal Singh who happens to be the husband of the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.28, dated 05.03.2013, P.S. Sadar Jalalabad, District Fazilka.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the petitioner had been approaching the police authorities for fair investigation in the matter and had even moved the representation (Annexure P-9) dated 01.12.2023.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to respondent No.2 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid

representation (Annexure P-9) in accordance with rules in an expeditious manner.

- 5. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4.
- 6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Daksh Prem Azad, AAG, Punjab, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent and submits that the representation (Annexure P-9) will be disposed of in accordance with rules in an expeditious manner.
- 7. After hearing the respective submissions and the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-Director General of Police, Punjab at Police Headquarter Punjab, Sector-9, Chandigarh, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 01.12.2023 (Annexure P-9) and dispose of the same in accordance with the rules after giving an opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner as well.
- 8. Decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.
