1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6, who are giving beatings to him.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that despite a complaint/representation having been made to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana dated 18.01.2024 (Annexure P-5) against respondents No.4 to 6, the police had been sitting over the matter and had till date not initiated any action against the erring officials much less submitting a challan against them. After arguing for some time, learned counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions could be issued to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into representation dated 18.01.2024 (Annexure P-5) which was sent through a registered post and take appropriate steps at the earliest.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Amandeep Singh Samra,

AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In view of the restricted prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the representation dated 18.01.2024 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps, if any, required, in accordance with law.
