Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to stay the departmental enquiry/proceedings initiated against the petitioner till the conclusion of the criminal proceedings pending against him on the basis of FIR lodged against him bearing FIR No.625 dated 15.09.2020 under Sections 306 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Shivaji Colony, Rohtak.
