DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

- [1] Petitioners are living in live-in relationship. They feel threat to their life and liberty on the part of private respondent Nos.4 to 9 and so have approached this Court to provide them with necessary protection.
- [2] It is contended that petitioner No.2 has not attained the age of marriage, as per Hindu Marriage Act and after attaining the age of 21 years, both the petitioner will marry each other.
- [3] Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only.
- [4] Mr. Rajeev K. Thakkar, learned DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3-State. Copy of paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.
- [5] Present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to provide necessary protection to the petitioners after assessing threat perception to their life.
