Petitioner was on bail, in a case arising out of FIR No.375 dated 24.12.2018 registered at Police Station Narwana City, District Jind under Section 174-A of the IPC, pending before learned SDJM, Narwana. He moved an application for seeking exemption on 01.12.2023 but after noticing his previous conduct of moving repeated applications for exemption, the same was declined. Bail earlier granted to the petitioner was cancelled. Bonds were forfeited and warrants of arrest were issued against him.

2. Learned counsel has prayed that liberty be granted to the petitioner by providing one opportunity to surrender before the Trial Court. Learned counsel has assured that petitioner will not move exemption application in future before the Trial Court concerned and will face trial regularly.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Parveen Kumar Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent- State.

5. Having regard to the assurance given by learned counsel to the effect that petitioner will not move any application for exemption in future, this petition is hereby disposed of with the direction to the petitioner to surrender before the Trial Court concerned on or before 20.03.2024.
6. On his such surrender, the Trial Court will be at liberty to initiate proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C. and after disposal of those proceedings, petitioner shall be admitted to bail. Till the disposal of the those proceedings, petitioner shall not be taken into custody.
7. If in the meantime, due to warrants of arrest or the procalamation proceedings having been initiated against the petitioner, in case he is sought to be arrested, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer.
8. Despite reptition it is made clear that petitioner will not move any application in future for seeking his exemption and will face the trial regularly.
