1. In the present petition, the grievance of the present petitioner is that the services of the petitioner has been terminated through a WatsApp message (Annexure P-6) on the ground that the petitioner has withheld the information *qua* his conviction under Section 13 of the Public Gambling Act, 1867 (Annexure P-2) but no actual written order has been passed by the respondents.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that appropriate written order *qua* the allegations alleged against the petitioner will be passed and till any such order is passed in writing, the petitioner will be allowed to continue in service.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, this action will be taken by

passing the formal written order and not by a verbal order and as per the petitioner no written order has been passed yet and the petitioner will be allowed to continue his service till any written order is passed *qua* the decision taken by the respondent with regard to the continuation of the services of the petitioners, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
