AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

1. The present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order No.1050-54 dated 25.01.2024, passed by respondent No.2, whereby the petitioner has been transferred from Borstal Jail, Ludhiana to Central Jail, Kapurthala.
2. Learned counsel would contend that the petitioner, who is working as Clerk, has transferred from Borstal Jail, Ludhiana to Central Jail, Kapurthala, regarding which, a representation dated 29.01.2024, Annexure P-4, has been submitted by him, which has yet not evoked any response. He thus, at this stage, on instructions, submits that the petitioner is sanguine of it being considered in a positive manner, in case, a direction is given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner by granting him an opportunity of hearing.
3. Notice of motion.
4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has no objection to the limited prayer made.

5. In view of the aforesaid and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider the representation dated 29.01.2024, Annexure P-4 and decide the same within a period of six weeks and in case of rejection thereof, an order giving reasons be passed, after associating the petitioner therewith.
