Present writ petition has been filed for directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 28.09.2023 (Annexure P-1) in time bound manner, whereby as per Jamabandi for the year 2007-08 (Annexure P-2), land in question has already been mutated in favour of the petitioner and her minor children.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted before this Court that for the redressal of grievance of the petitioner, she has already filed her representation dated 28.09.2023 (Annexure P-1) before respondent No.2 but no decision has been taken on the same till date. He further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 i.e. Tehsildar, Ludhiana (East), Ludhiana to decide the representation dated 28.09.2023 (Annexure P-1) in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Navneet Singh, Sr. DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. He has submitted that the representation filed by the petitioner before respondent No.2 would be decided expeditiously.

In view of the above position, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Tehsildar, Ludhiana (East), Ludhiana to look into the representation of the petitioner dated 28.09.2023 (Annexure P-1) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order which will be supplied to him forthwith by the petitioners.
