NAMIT KUMAR, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner claiming the following relief:-

- “ (i) issue a writ in the nature of Certiorari quashing condition no.4 in the appointment order, annexure P-10, to the effect that directing the petitioner to produce Certificate of Domicile of Punjab as well as quashing impugned order, annexure P-13, issued by respondents No.2 and 3 respectively, being arbitrary and illegal;
- (ii) issue a writ in the nature of Mandamus commanding the respondent authorities to allow the petitioner to continue working on the post of Accounts Clerk on which post, he has been newly appointed vide appointment order, annexure P-10 and joined with effect from 11.07.2001 regularly in the category of Handicapped persons against the post reserved for Handicapped category persons;
- (vii) operation of impugned condition no.4 in the impugned appointment order, annexure P-10 as well as operation of the impugned order, Annexure P-13 be stayed. ”

2. Learned counsel for Respondent Nos.2 and 3 submits that the petitioner continued in service and submitted resignation dated 23.11.2005, which was accepted by the respondent-Corporation and he was relieved from his duties on 05.12.2005, therefore, the relief claimed by the petitioner in the present petition has become infructuous.
3. Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, however, liberty is granted to the petitioner to seek revival of this petition, in case, anything still survives.
4. All pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
