Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.145 dated 11.8.2023 registered under Sections 21(1) of Mines and Minerals Act and Section 379 IPC at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran.

- 2. Counsel for the petitioner apprised the Court that by virtue of the order of interim bail passed by this Court on the last date of hearing, the petitioner has joined investigation with the police.
- 3. State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurdip Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the recovery in this case was effected from the spot and the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.
- 4. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the

case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated

16.2.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
