1. This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 for conducting free and fair inquiry in case FIR No. 0007 dated 20.11.2023 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 406/420 of IPC, registered at Police Station NRI, Bathinda, District Bathinda from any higher official or special investigation team and take appropriate legal action against the respondent private respondents.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied, in case a direction be issued to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to decide the representation (Annexure P-2) within a time bound manner.
3. Notice to the official respondents only at this stage.
4. On asking of Court, Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.
5. Without advertng to the facts of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda to look into the grievances unfolded

by the petitioner in his representation dated 29.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) and to decide the same by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

- 6. A copy of order so passed by supplied to the petitioner within one week thereafter.
- 7. Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
