Challenge is to impugned judgment dated 04.12.2023 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Sangrur whereby the appeal against judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 30.11.2012 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Malerkotla was allowed by setting aside and reversing the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 30.11.2012 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Malerkotla.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Parween Kumar, submits that the appellant has since expired. It is further informed that the accused/respondents No. 2 to 4 herein were convicted by the learned trial Court vide judgment dated 30.11.2012

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passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Malerkotla in case FIR No. 159 dated 10.12.2007 registered under Sections 447, 354, 323 and 34 IPC at Police Station Malerkotla. Thereafter, in an appeal filed by respondents No. 2 to 4/accused, they stood acquitted vide judgment dated 04.12.2013 and in the said circumstances, the present appeal came to be filed.

Since the appellant/complainant has expired, the present appeal is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous/abated.
