1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant regular bail in case FIR No.96 dated 19.07.2023 registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 148, 149 of IPC, at Police Station City-I, Mansa, District Mansa.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely involved in the present case and was arrested on 25.08.2023. He further contends that as per case of the prosecution, the petitioner had caused injuries with a baseball bat on the right leg of Gurpal Singh, injured. He next contends that all the injuries suffered by Gurpal Singh have been declared to be simple in nature. Learned counsel further contends that in the present case, the right leg of Arman Parocha @ Pulsar, injured was got amputated. However, as per case of the prosecution, the petitioner had not caused any injury to Arman Paroch @ Pulsar. The final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been

presented against him. He further contends that similarly placed co-accused Jashjandeep Singh @ Jassu and Jashan Singh alias Jassi alias Jashandeep Singh have already been granted the concession of bail by this Court, vide orders Annexures P-8 and P-9, respectively.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

5. The petitioner was arrested in the present case on 25.08.2023 and is in custody for the last more than 06 months and challan has already been presented against him. Even the injury, which is attributed to the petitioner, is simple in nature. However, similarly placed co-accused Jashjandeep Singh @ Jassu and Jashan Singh alias Jassi alias Jashandeep Singh have already been granted the concession of bail by this Court vide orders Annexures P-8 and P-9, respectively.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned.
