The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.260 dated 26.12.2023, under Sections 408 and 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.6, District Ludhiana.

This Court vide order dated 16.02.2024, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.
