The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioners on completion of three years of service in accordance with the policy dated 23.01.2001 and the review policy dated 28.03.2002, as the petitioners have completed more than five years of continuous service.

2. There was no representation on behalf of the petitioners and respondent Nos.3 and 4 on the last date of hearing i.e. 07.05.2024 and notices were ordered to be issued to Mr. R.S. Manhas, Advocate, counsel for the petitioners and Mr. S. S. Virk, Advocate, counsel for respondent Nos.3 and 4.

3. As per office report, both the counsels have been informed through email.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Ms. Harpreet Kaur, Sr. Assistant, Local Govt. Department, Punjab, submits that out of total 18

petitioners, 04 have died and the services of the remaining petitioners have been



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regularized as Sewerman on 22.12.2011.

5. In this view of the matter, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
