The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.159 dated 24.12.2023 registered under Sections 323, 307, 452, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Division No.2, District Jalandhar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 15.02.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.
