1. By this common order, a bunch of 13 petitions is hereby

disposed of since issues involved and prayer sought in the captioned petitions are common.

2. The petitioner through instant petitions under Article 226 of the Constitution is seeking setting aside of impugned awards whereby workmen were held entitled to reinstatement alongwith 50% back wages.

3. The petitioner is a State Government undertaking and engaged in the business of manufacturing sugar.

4. Mr. P.K. Mutneja, Sr. Advocate submits that as per his instructions, all the workmen were permitted to rejoin. They rejoined. A few of them have passed away and a few have retired on attaining the age of superannuation. 1 or 2 workers are still continuing. In these circumstances, the instant petitions may be disposed of.

5. In the wake of statement of Mr. P.K. Mutneja, Sr. Advocate, without commenting upon merits, present petitions stand disposed of.

6. Pending misc. application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
