This application has been filed for amendment of title and prayer clause in the main petition as during investigation of FIR No. 26 dated 22.01.2024, Sections 468 and 471 IPC have been added in the above said FIR.

For the reasons recorded in the application, the same is allowed.

Main case

The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.26, dated 22.01.2024 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 406/420/468/471 of the IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Civil Line, Kaithal.

This Court vide order dated 20.02.2024, while issuing notice of motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.



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Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 20.02.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Investigating Officer and in view of the stand taken by him in the affidavit to the extent that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required, the order dated 20.02.2024 is made absolute.

However, proceedings before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court as per order dated 29.05.2024 passed by this Court may continue and parties shall be at liberty to move accordingly as per its outcome thereof.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.

Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
