1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari or any other appropriate writ/order or direction for setting aside the impugned show cause notice dated 02.02.2024 (Annexure P-1) issued by Superintendent of Police, Rohtak (respondent No.3).

2. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents-State has submitted that the present writ petition is premature, inasmuch as, only show cause notice has been issued and the petitioner has been granted time to file reply/representation within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the said communication.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the same, the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with

liberty to file reply to the show cause notice dated 02.02.2024 and to take all the pleas which are available to her in the said reply and has prayed that a period of 10 days be granted for filing the reply and the competent authority of the respondent-State be directed to consider the same before passing the final order.

4. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present writ petition, however, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file reply to the show cause notice dated 02.02.204 within a period of 10 days from today and in case the reply is filed by the petitioner within the aforesaid period, the competent authority would consider the same before passing the final order.
