Report of the Warrant Officer has been received, who went to the house of respondent No.4. The alleged detainee – Amritpal Kaur, the wife of the petitioner was found present there. She made a statement that though she was interested to go with her husband i.e. petitioner after the consent of her parents and other relatives but she needed some time to take decision. Copy of the statement of the alleged detainee is Annexure A.

In view of the afore-said statement of the alleged detainee, it is clear that she is not being illegally detained by her parents- respondent No.4.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Des Raj, has also made a statement that the alleged detainee Amritpal Kaur is not being detained illegally.

In view of the afore-said report of the Warrant Officer, no further order is required to be passed by this Court. However, petitioner is at liberty to avail other alternative remedies in accordance with law.
