This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobeying the order dated 24.01.2020 passed by this Court in CWP-16878-2018.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Compliance report by way of affidavit of Ashok Kumar Meena, Excise and Taxation Commissioner, Haryana, Panchkula has been filed by learned counsel for the respondent today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it appropriate place.

Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the order dated 24.01.2020 passed by this Court in CWP-16878-2018 has been complied with and licence fee has been refunded to the petitioner, vide pay order dated 25.01.2024 (Annexure R-2).

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
