1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.0012 dated 20.01.2024, registered under Sections 294, 382, 506, 323, 149 of IPC, at Police Station Bahawala, District Fazilka.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition qua petitioner No.3.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioner No.3, only.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 15.02.2024 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, petitioners No.1, 2 and 4 have joined the investigation.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Jaswinder Singh, has submitted that petitioners No.1, 2 and 4 have joined the investigation on 01.03.2024 and are no longer required for further investigation.



6. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 15.02.2024, passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute. The petitioners No.1, 2 and 4 shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
